Proposals should include an abstract of approx. 150 words, together with your name, title and institution. Papers will be 20mins followed by 10min discussion.

We would be particularly interested to receive submissions on the theme of Liturgy in a Time of War, but papers on any topic reflecting recent research will be considered.
